EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14 Series of 2013

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RE-CONSTITUTING THE COMPOSITION OF THE GENERAL SANTOS CITY TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (GENSANTRAMCO).

WHEREAS, in the recent elections the people had bestowed the new mandate to the present administration;

WHEREAS, with such development, there is a need to reconstitute the composition of the General Santos City Transportation Management Committee (GENSANTRAMCO) still within the purview of Ordinance No. 22 Series of 2002, as amended by Ordinance No. 2 Series of 2012;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RONNEL C. RIVERA, City Mayor of General Santos City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law and the sovereign will of the people, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. — **COMPOSITION.** The General Santos City Transportation Management Committee (GENSANTRAMCO) shall be composed of fourteen (members), consisting of four (4) individuals coming from the private sector to be selected by their respective sector as representative to the Committee and ten (10) shall be ex-officio members, namely:

- a. The District Head of the Land Transportation Office, General Santos City;
- b. The City Legal Officer/City Attorney;
- c. The City Prosecutor;
- d. The City Director of the Philippine National Police;
- e. Any member of the Motorized Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board;
- f. The Head of the City Planning and Development Coordinator's Office;
- g. The Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation, Communications, and Franchises of the Sangguniang Panlungsod;
- h. The City Engineer;
- The President of the Liga ng mga Barangay;
- The regional representative/alternate of the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board.

The four (4) Committee Members coming from the Private Sector shall be as follows:

- Representative from the General Santos City Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc.;
- b. The President of the Federation of Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (TODA);
- The President of the Federation of Public Utility Vehicles (Jeepneys & Multi-Cab) Operators and Drivers Association/Cooperatives;
- d. The President of the GSC Consumer's Welfare Association

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. — All orders, memoranda, rules and regulations, or any part/s thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are

hereby revoked or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. — If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Order not otherwise affected shall remain in full force and effect.
